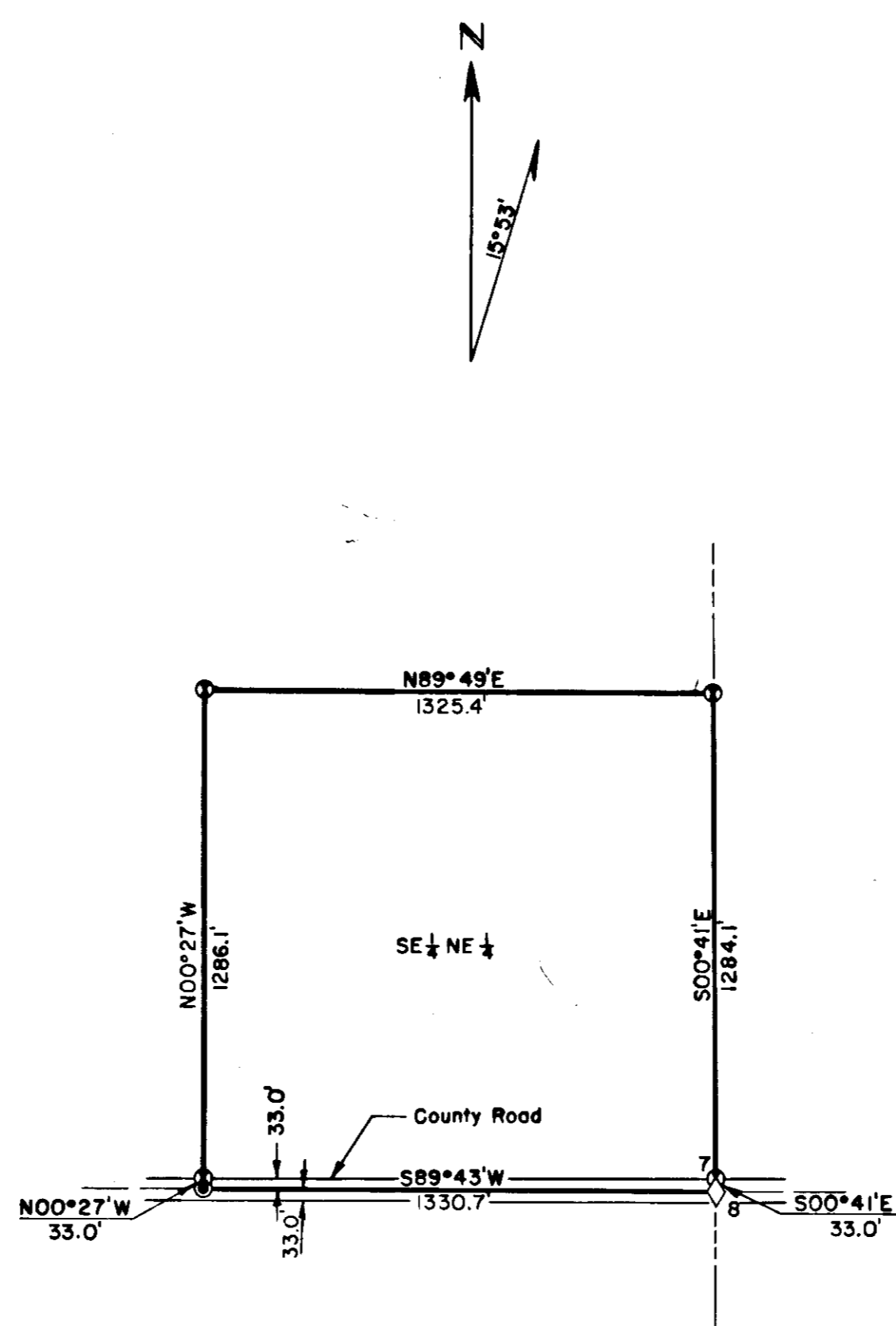
SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

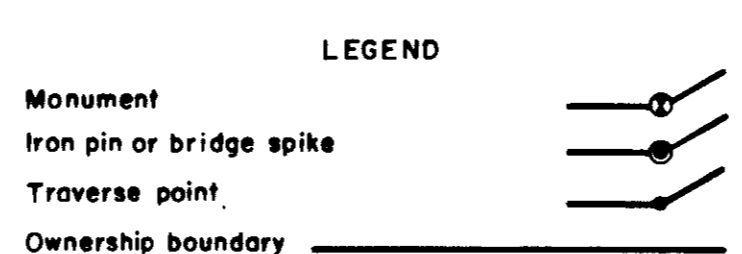
