

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That The Colony Coal Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Colorado, does hereby certify that the above or foregoing FRULLO ADDITION TO ROCK SPRINGS, WYOMING, situate in the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter (SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section Thirty (30) in Township Nineteen (19) North, Range One Hundred Five (105) West of the Sixth (6) Meridian, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point in the East boundary of the West half of the Southwest quarter of the west quarter (W<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of said section 36 that is North twenty seven degrees thirty six and forty three seconds East (N 27° 36' 43" E) one thousand four hundred sixteen and eleven hundredths (1416.11) feet from the Southwest corner of Section 36, T. 19 N. R. 105 W.; thence South nine degrees fifty two minutes East (S 9° 52' E) thirty one and fourteen hundredths (31.14) feet; thence South twenty two degrees thirty seven minutes East (S 22° 37' E) four hundred fifty and seventy one hundredths (450.71) feet; thence South eighty nine degrees fifty two minutes East (S 89° 52' E) one hundred twenty six and seven hundredths (126.7) feet; thence South thirty degrees thirty seven minutes East (S 30° 37' E) three hundred two and fifteen hundredths (302.15) feet; thence South four degrees thirty seven minutes East (S 4° 37' E) eighty and eight hundredths (80.08) feet; thence North eighty nine degrees fifty two minutes West (N 89° 52' W) three hundred fifty and ninety four hundredths (350.94) feet; thence North no degrees twelve minutes and thirty six seconds West (N 0° 12' 36" W) seven hundred and ninety five and thirty six hundredths (795.36) feet, more or less, along the East line of the West half of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter (W<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of section 36 to the point of beginning, an area of four and one hundredths (4.01) acres, more or less.

That said subdivision as appears on this plat is with the free consent, and in accordance with the desires of the undersigned owner and proprietor, that if it is the owner in fee thereof, that the foregoing is a correct plot of said subdivision, and that the dimensions of the lots, blocks, streets and alleys are correctly shown on said plat, and the courses of a foot and the courses of the streets and alleys are correctly shown on said plat, and the undersigned hereby dedicates to use all the streets and alleys or parts thereof within the boundaries of the subdivision as shown upon the foregoing and annexed plat, but reserves the right to mine and remove the same by underground workings, so long as said mining and removal of minerals may be done without interfering with the use of the streets, it being expressly understood and agreed that The Colony Coal Company, its successors and assigns, shall not be liable for any damage or injury to any existing easements or rights of way.


