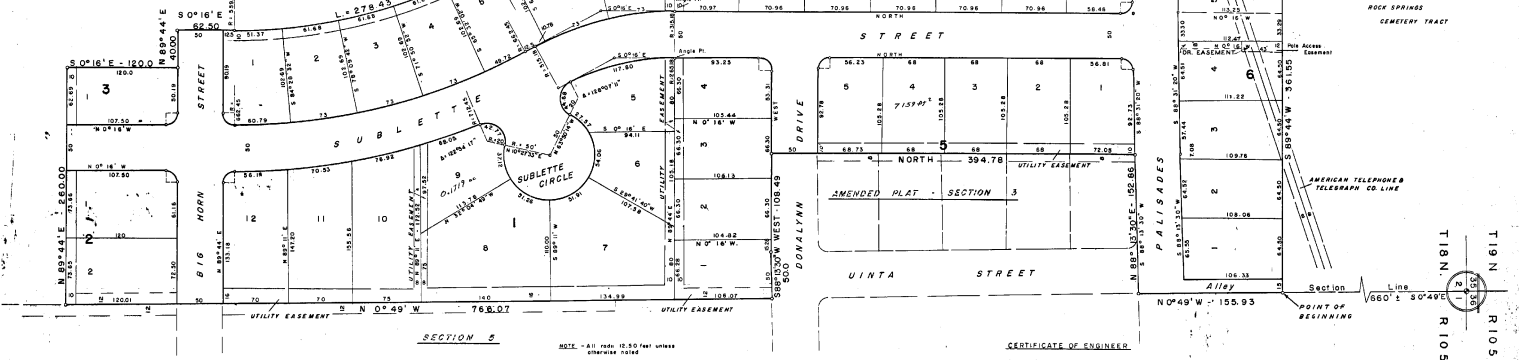

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the B & N Development Company, a Wyoming corporation, does hereby certify that the COUNTRY CLUB ESTATES ADDITION - 6TH SECTION to Rock Springs, Sweetwater County, Wyoming, is located in Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE 1/4 NE 1/4 NE 1/4) and the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4 SE 1/4 NE 1/4) of Section Two (2), Township Eighteen (18) North, Range One Hundred Five (105) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian and is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is the Southeast corner of the N 1/2 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 18 North, Range 105 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, said point of beginning being South 0° 49' East, a distance of 660 feet, more or less, from the Northeast corner of said Section 2; thence South 89° 44' West, a distance of 361.55 feet; thence South 0° 16' East, a distance of 113.25 feet; thence South 89° 44' West, a distance of 49.98 feet; thence South 0° 16' East, a distance of 546.72 feet; thence point of a curve to the left the radius of which is 417.87 feet; thence along said curve through an angle of 28° 30', a distance of 207.86 feet; thence South 28° 46' East, a distance of 12.50 feet to the point of a curve to the right, the radius of which is 559.76 feet; thence along said curve through an angle of 28° 30', a distance of 278.43 feet; thence South 0° 16' East, a distance of 62.50 feet; thence North 89° 44' East, a distance of 400.00 feet; thence South 0° 16' East, a distance of 100.00 feet; thence North 89° 44' East, a distance of 280.00 feet to a point on the East line of said Section 2; thence North 0° 49' West along the East line of said Section 2, a distance of 766.07 feet; thence South 88° 13' 30' West, a distance of 200.00 feet; thence West, a distance of 108.49 feet; thence North, along the westerly line of Block 3, Amended Plat of the COUNTRY CLUB ESTATES ADDITION - 3RD SECTION, a distance of 394.78 feet; thence North 88° 13' 30' East, a distance of 152.88 feet; thence North 0° 49' West, a distance of 152.93 feet to the point of beginning; said parcel contains 9.754 acres, more or less.

That the said addition as appears upon this plat, is made with the free consent, and in accord with the desires of the undersigned owner and proprietor, that said Company is the owner thereof, that the foregoing is a correct plat of said addition as surveyed and staked into lots, blocks, streets, and alleys, and that the dimensions thereof are correctly shown by figures representing feet and decimals of a foot, and the courses of the streets and alleys are correctly shown hereon, and the undersigned hereby dedicates to public use all streets and alleys within the boundary lines of said addition as shown on this plat, reserving, however, oil, gas and other minerals, except coal, underlying said land, and the right to prospect for, mine, and remove the same so long as such operations may be conducted without unreasonably interfering with the use of the surface, as set forth in the deed from Coloway Coal Company to W. A. Neitler, it being expressly understood and agreed that the

Coloway Coal Company, its successors and assigns, shall not be liable for any damage or injury resulting from the subsidence of the surface of the land described above within the boundary lines of this addition. This dedication is made subject to any existing easements or rights of way.
