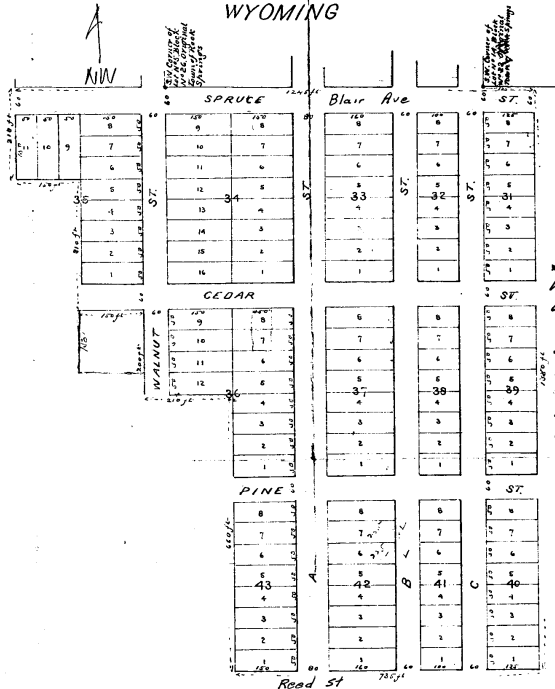


UNION PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY'S SECOND ADDITION TO Rock Springs

SWEET WATER COUNTY
WYOMING



Description of the tract of land included in the Second Addition to Rock Springs, Wyo. reference being had to the plat showing hereunto attached and made a part of this description.

Commencing at a point on the south line of block No 22 on the original town of Rock Springs, 125 feet north easterly from the south west corner of said block No 22, thence south easterly at right angles 1380 feet, thence south westerly at right angles 735 feet, thence north westerly at right angles 660 feet, thence south westerly at right angles 210 feet, thence north westerly at right angles 200 feet, thence south westerly at right angles 150 feet, thence north westerly at right angles 310 feet, thence south westerly at right angles 750 feet, thence north westerly at right angles 210 feet, thence north easterly at right angles 1245 feet to point of beginning.
