UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY hereby certifies that the above or foregoing 1919 First Addition to the Town of Green River, Wyoming, is located on that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW 1/4 of NW 1/4) of Section No. Twenty-three (23), Township Sixty-eight (68) West, and Range One Hundred and Seven (107) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, in Sweetwater County, Wyoming, as described as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW 1/4 of NW 1/4) of said Section Twenty-three (23), and running Northwesterly along the line of Block Two (2) in the original Town of Green River, as surveyed, pulled and recorded, thence Southwesterly parallel with and forty (40) feet distant Northwesterly, to a point in the original Town of Green River, thence Southwesterly parallel with and Seven Hundred Twenty (720) feet distant Northwesterly, of right angles, from the extension Northwesterly of the Southwesterly line of Block Thirteen (13) in said original Town of Green River, thence Southwesterly parallel with and Sixty (60) feet distant Northwesterly, of right angles, to a point in the extension Southwesterly of the Southwesterly line of the way in Block Thirteen (13) in said original Town of Green River, thence Southwesterly parallel with and Sixty (60) feet distant Northwesterly, of right angles, to a point in the extension Southwesterly of the Southwesterly line of the way in Block Thirteen (13) in said original Town of Green River, thence Southwesterly parallel with and Sixty (60) feet distant Northwesterly, of right angles, to a point in the extension Southwesterly of the Southwesterly line of the way in Block Thirteen (13) in said original Town of Green River, thence Southwesterly parallel with and Sixty (60) feet distant Northwesterly, of right angles, to a point in the extension Southwesterly of the Southwesterly line of the way in Block Thirteen (13) in said original Town of Green River, thence North along the west line of said forty (40) acre tract to the point of beginning.

ADDITIONAL TO THE TOWN OF GREEN RIVER, WYOMING, as appears on this plot is with the consent and in accordance with the desires of the undersigned owners and proprietors, and that it is the desire of the same that the same be first mortgaged by Union Pacific Railroad Company to the Bankers Trust Company, and then sold to the public, and that the same be sold in the County of Sweetwater and State of Wyoming, and that the foregoing is a correct plot of said 1919 First Addition, and that the dimensions and boundaries of the same shall be determined by the said UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY, and that the same be figures representing feet and decimal of a foot, as the said UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY hereby dedicates to the public all streets and alleys as shown upon the foregoing plan.


