UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY hereby certifies that the above or foregoing 1919 First Addition to the Town of Green River Wyoming, is located on that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (S.W. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4) of Section No. 23, Township No. 23 N., Range No. 107 W., the Hundred and Seventy (170) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, in Sweetwater County, Wyoming, as shown as follows, to-wit:

The line of the extension southeasterly of the northwestern line of Block Three (23), thence east along the north line of said Forty (40) acre tract to a point which is forty (40) feet distant Northeast, at right angles, from the extension southeasterly of the northwestern line of Block Three (23) to the original town of Green River, as surveyed, plotted and recorded, thence southeasterly parallel with and forty (40) feet distant Northeast, at right angles, from the extension southeasterly of the northwestern line of said Block Three (23) to a point which is Seven Hundred and Twenty (720) feet distant, southeasterly, at right angles, from the extension northeasterly of the southeasterly line of Block Three (23) to the extension southeasterly of the northwestern line of Block Three (23) to a point which is Seven Hundred and Twenty (720) feet distant, southeasterly, at right angles, from the extension southeasterly of the northwestern line of Block Three (23) to a point in the west line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (S.W. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4) of said Section Twenty-three (23), thence north along the west line of said Block Three (23) to the point of beginning.

And that the survey and staking thereof into blocks and fractional blocks and streets and alleys as said 1919 First Addition to the town of Green River, Wyoming, as appears on this plat is in accordance with the design of the undersigned owners and proprietors, and that it is the same in the sample thereof, subject to the first mortgage of Union Pacific Railroad Company to the Bankers Trust Company of New York, dated July 1st, 1897, and duly recorded in the County of Sweetwater and State of Wyoming, and that the foregoing is a correct and true and true and true plat of the dimensions of the blocks and fractional blocks and the widths of the said streets and alleys as correctly indicated on the plat by figures appearing hereon and as shown on the plat, and that the said UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY hereby dedicates to the public use all streets and alleys as shown upon the foregoing plat.

BANKERS TRUST COMPANY, as Trustee of the mortgage hereinabove referred to, hereby joins in the above dedication. 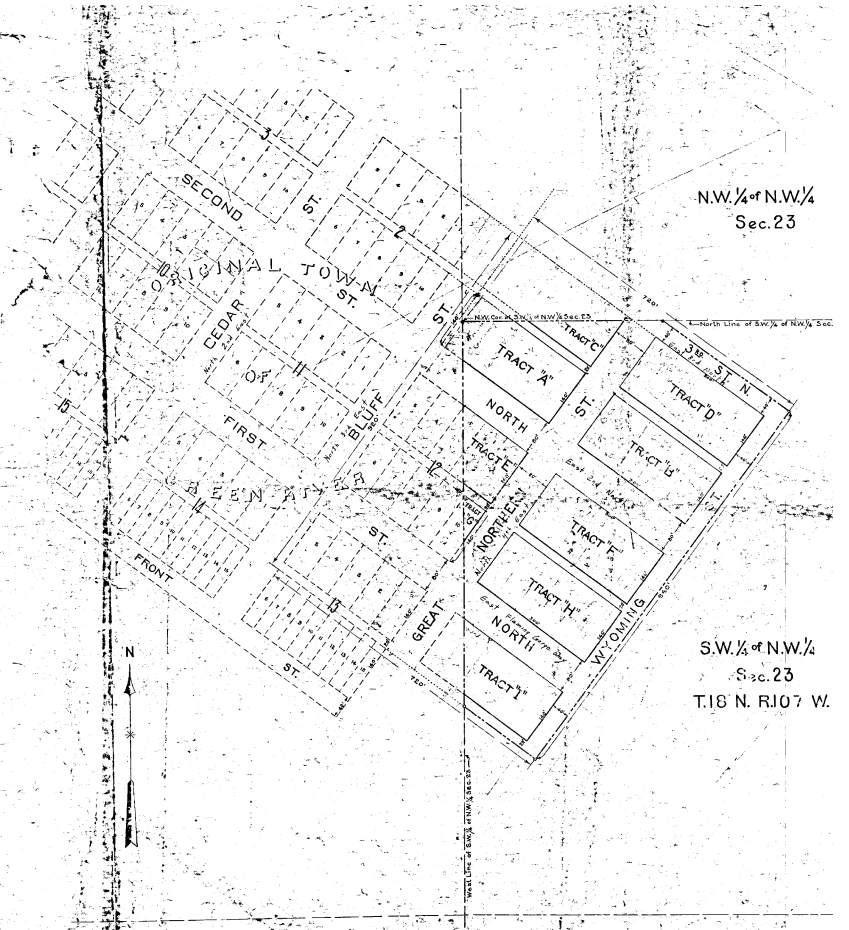
