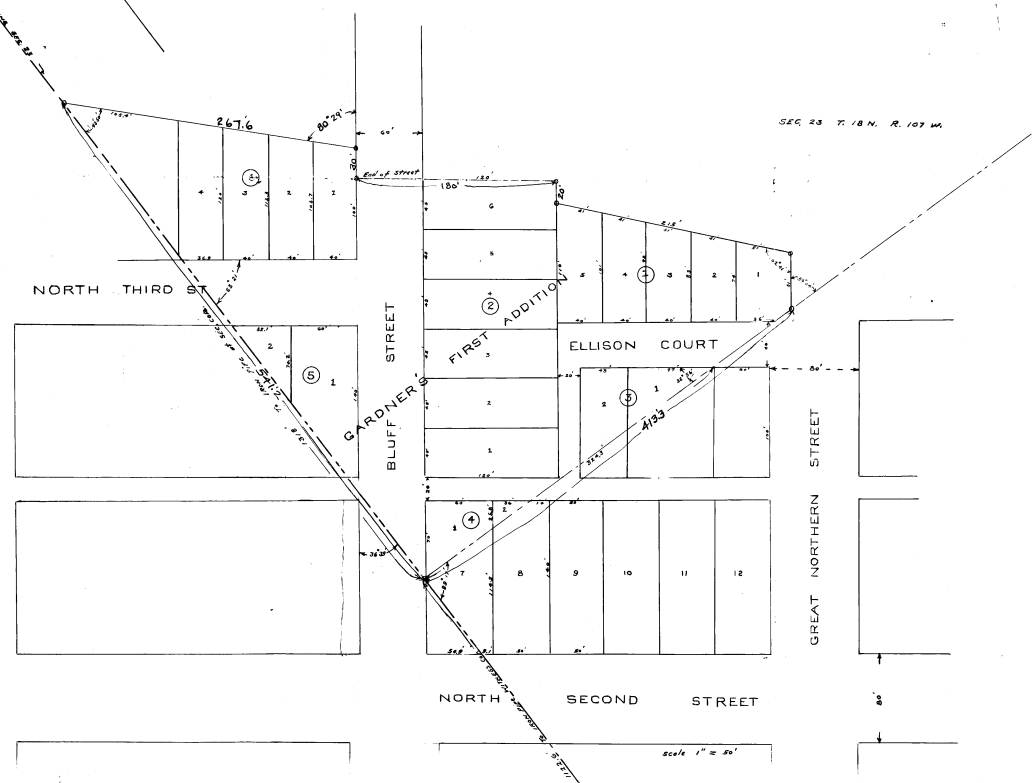


Description Gardner's First Addition.
 An irregular tract of land lying in the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 23 T. 18 N. R. 107 W of the 6th principal meridian and more particularly described as follows, to wit: beginning at a point on the west line of section 23, T. 18 N. R. 107 W, said point being 1318 feet south of the northwest corner of said section 23, thence S. 89° 17' E. a distance of 413.3 feet to a stake, thence N. 36° 39' E. a distance of 57 feet to a stake, thence N. 40° 40' W. a distance of 215 feet to a stake, thence N. 36° 39' E. a distance of 20 feet to a stake, thence N. 36° 39' W. a distance of 180 feet to a stake, thence N. 43° 50' E. a distance of 267.6 feet to a stake, thence south along the west line of Sec. 23 a distance of 341.2 feet to the point of beginning.
