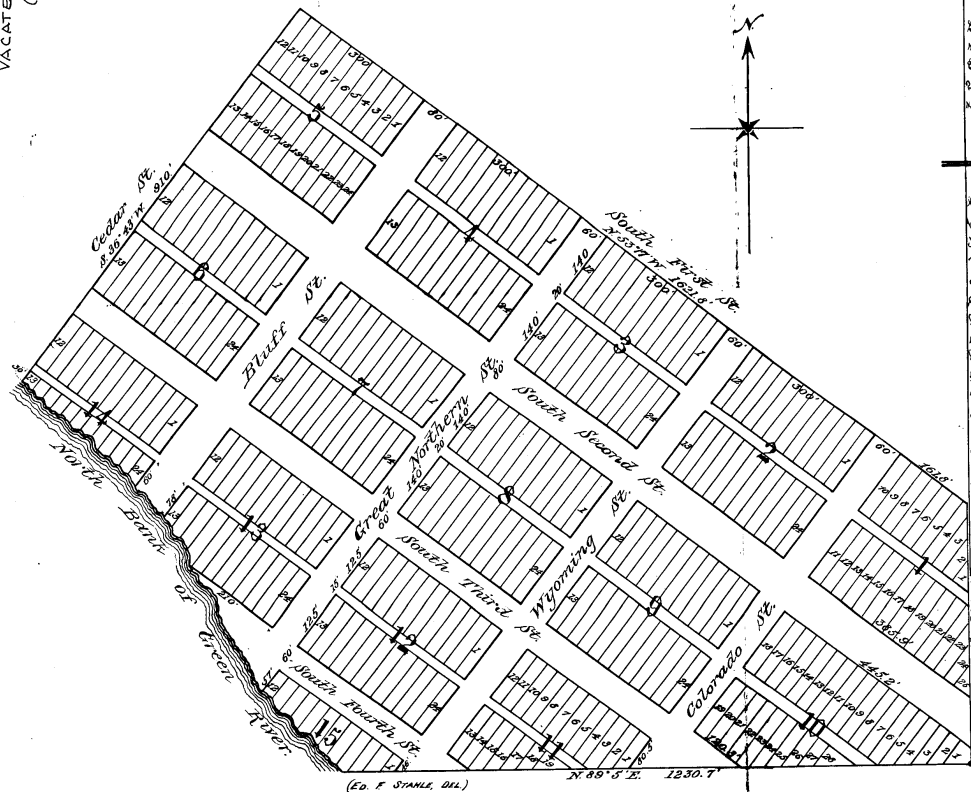
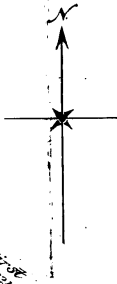


VACATED BY PLAT 55

I do hereby certify that I have surveyed into Blocks, Streets and Alleys, Carpenter Addition to the Town of Green River, the same comprising portions of the South half of the North East quarter, and North half of the South East quarter of Sec. 22, T. 18 N., R. 107 W., and the foregoing plat is correct according to such survey.

The foregoing subdivisions of Sec. 22, T. 18 N., R. 107 W. as set down to wit: Beginning at a point 1320 feet North of the true North line to sections 22, 23, 24, 27, T. 18 N., R. 107 W., running thence North, 514.4 feet, thence along a line parallel to the line of South First Street, in the Town of Green River, as said street is shown on the plat of said Town now on file in the office of the County Clerk and returns Register of Deeds of Sweetwater County, 1891, 8 feet to the intersection of projected East line of Cedar Street in said Town: thence S. 36° 45' W. along a line parallel to the East line of Cedar Street, 450 feet, to the North Bank of Green River: thence in an easterly direction immediately along the North Bank of said Green River to the intersection of South line of the North half of the South East quarter of Section 22, T. 18 N., R. 107 W.: thence N. 58° 5' E. along said line 1320.7 feet to place of beginning, containing 39.28 acres more or less, as appears on this plat is with the feet correct and in accordance with the desire of the under- signed owner and proprietor, and the streets and alleys therein shown are hereby dedicated perpetually to the public use.
