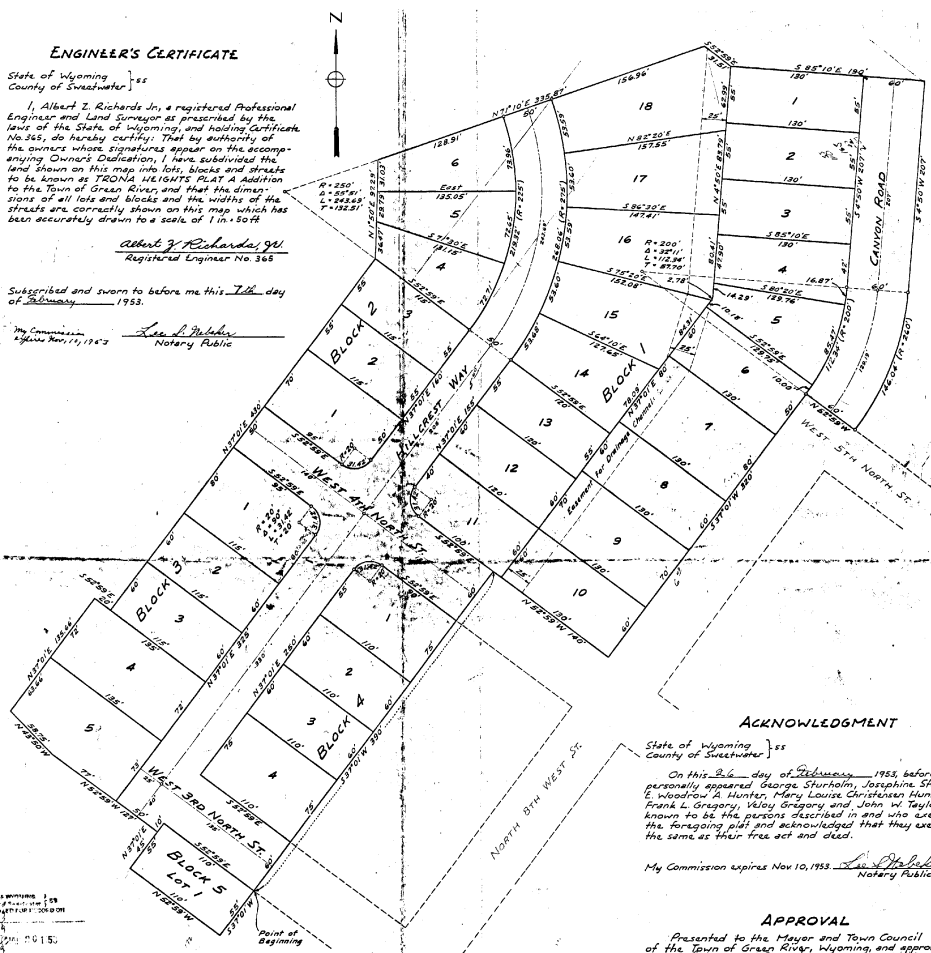

OWNER'S DEDICATION

Know all men by these presents that George Sturholm and Josephine Sturholm, husband and wife; E. Woodrow A. Hunter and Mary Louise Christensen Hunter, husband and wife; Frank L. Gregory and Veloy Gregory, husband and wife, and J. Marlow Taylor, John W. Taylor, Frank C. Stevens and S. Reed Dayton, a partnership, doing business as Taylor, Stevens and Dayton, the owners of the tract of land shown on this map, have caused the same to be subdivided into lots, blocks and streets and do hereby dedicate to the perpetual use of the public all streets shown hereon, and they do hereby certify that the foregoing TRONA HEIGHTS PLAT A Addition to the Town of Green River, Wyoming, in the County of Sweetwater, is located in the South-west Quarter of Section 15, Township 18 North, Range 107 West, of the Sixth Principal Meridian, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point N 89° 10' E 50.00 ft from the northwesterly corner of Lot 6, Block 6, of Union Pacific Railroad Company's Third Addition to Green River Town (which point of beginning is on the northwesterly boundary line of said lot 6 extended in a northwesterly direction; said point of beginning also being a distance of 140 ft in a northwesterly direction from the southeasterly boundary corner of the Jefferson School Addition) and running thence S 37° 10' W 55.00 ft, thence N 52° 58' W 110.00 ft, thence N 37° 02' E 45.00 ft, thence N 52° 58' W 121.00 ft, thence N 42° 10' W 58.15 ft, thence N 52° 10' E 135.44 ft, thence S 52° 58' E 20.00 ft, thence S 17° 01' E 430.00 ft, thence N 7° 50' E 92.00 ft, thence N 71° 10' E 315.00 ft, thence S 20° 58' E 315.00 ft, thence S 82° 10' E 150.00 ft, thence S 4° 16' W 30.00 ft, thence along a 200 ft radius curve to the right a distance of 156.00 ft to the northwesterly boundary line of all blocks, thence running thence along the northwesterly boundary line of 5th North St. a distance of 60 ft to the northwesterly property line of 8th West St., thence S 77° 10' W along the northwesterly property line of 8th West St. a distance of 200 ft to the northwesterly property line of 4th North St., thence N 52° 58' W along the northwesterly property line of 4th North St. a distance of 140.00 ft, thence S 37° 10' W 350.00 ft to the point of beginning.

That the survey and taking thereof into lots, blocks and streets as TRONA HEIGHTS PLAT A Addition to the Town of Green River, Wyoming, as appears on this plat, is with the free consent and in accordance with the desire of the owners and proprietors hereof, whose names, addresses, occupations, subject to the the reservations contained in the plat and in the deed from the Union Pacific Railroad to George Sturholm and that the foregoing is a correct plat of said TRONA HEIGHTS PLAT A Addition to the Town of Green River, and that the dimensions of the lots and blocks and the widths of the streets are correctly shown on the plat by figures representing feet and decimals of a foot.
