

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

That Bullrite Homes, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Wyoming does hereby certify that the Sunset Addition in the City of Rock Springs, Wyoming, is located in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW 1/4 SE 1/4) of Section Twenty-five (25), Eesurvey, Township Nineteen (19), North Range One Hundred five (105), West, Sixth Principal Meridian, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the south line of the said Section 25, said point being located South 89°10' East 94.25 feet from the South Quarter corner of the section, thence South 89°10' East along the section line 940 feet, thence North 89°10' East 363.0 feet, thence North 81°25' West 479.2 feet, thence North 83°10' West 325.0 feet, thence South 55.0 feet to the point of beginning. The area of this tract is 12.05 Acres, more or less.

And the siting thereof, into streets, blocks and lots, as appears on this plat as the said Sunset Addition is with the free consent and in accordance with the desires of the undersigned owner of the above described land, subject to the consent of the persons contained in said order and from Union Pacific Railroad Company, that this is a correct plat of the said Sunset Addition, the dimensions being shown by figures representing feet and decimals of feet.

And the undersigned owner hereby dedicates to the public use all of the streets shown hereon.

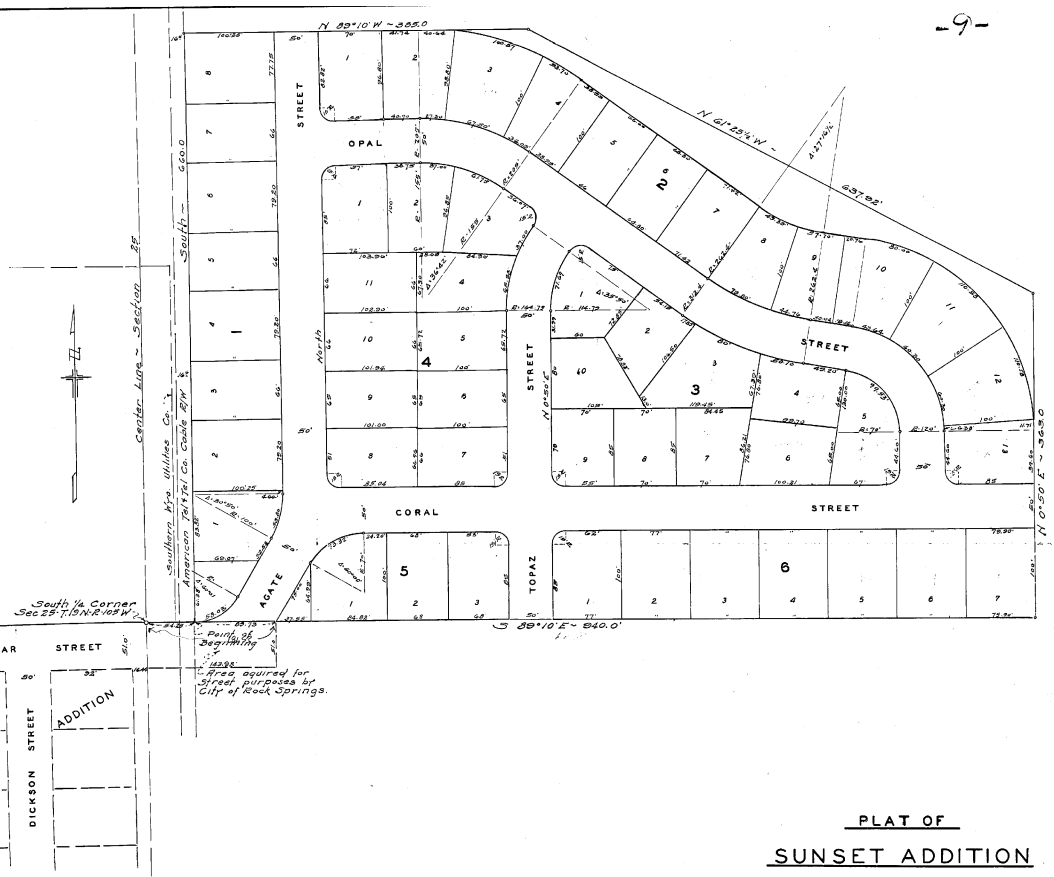
